Talad engelska och texter från olika medier - Engelska, Årskurs 7-9

Syfte

Eleverna ska använda engelska utanför klassrummet i syfte att utveckla sitt språk.

Läraren reflekterar

30-day-challenge är resultatet av ett samarbete i FB-gruppen [Engelska i åk 6-9](#). Emmeli Johansson kom med idén, Mia Smith strukturerade upp idéerna i Google Drive och därefter har flertalet lärare bidragit med tips. Tack alla som bidragit!

Uppgiften är enkel att genomföra och innehåller många olika typer av uppgifter (läsa, tala, lyssna, skriva, ord), vilket innebär att eleverna tränar språket på ett roligt och varierat sätt. Dessutom kan eleverna välja uppgift beroende av tid, ork och lust.

Metod och uppgifter

This challenge is to make you use your English more outside the classroom. Five days every week for 30 days I want you to do at least one thing from the list. Fill in the grid each day with what you have done. Try to do as many different things as possible. You can only do each assignment three times.

Centralt innehåll

Talad engelska och texter från olika medier. Muntliga och skriftliga instruktioner och beskrivningar. Olika former av samtal, dialoger, intervjuer och muntliga framställningar.

Kunskapskrav

Eleven kan förstå **såväl helhet som detaljer** i talad engelska i måttligt tempo samt i lättillgängliga texter i olika genrer. Eleven visar sin förståelse genom att **välgrundat och nyanserat** redogöra för, diskutera och kommentera innehåll och detaljer samt genom att med **gott** resultat agera utifrån budskap och instruktioner i innehållet.

I muntliga och skriftliga framställningar i olika genrer kan elever formulera sig **relativt varierat, tydligt och sammanhängande**.
